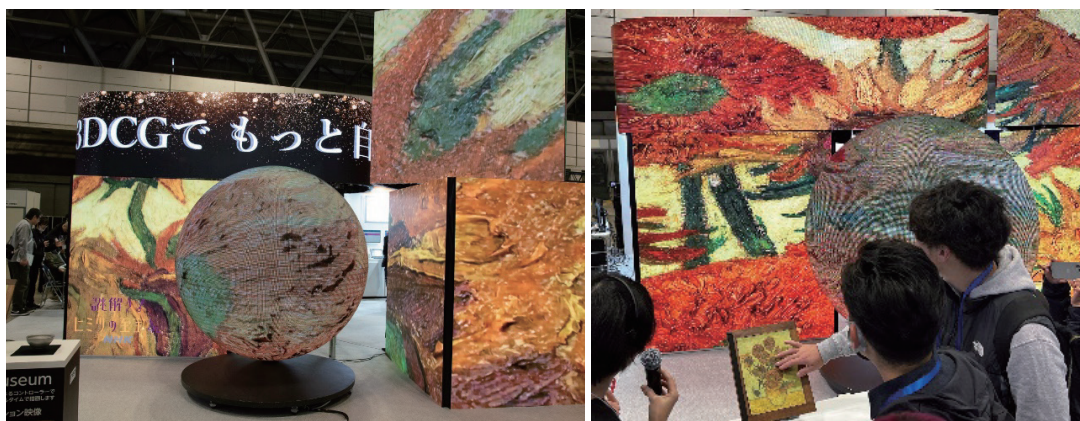

Fukui Edition

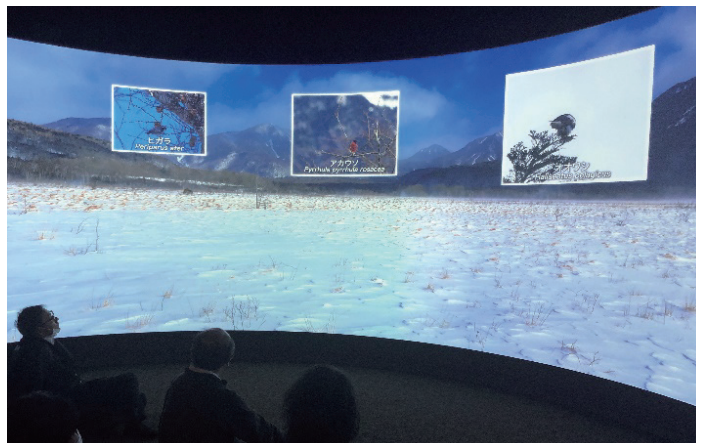

Observe the natural beauty of Oku-Nikko through two immersive installations with minimal text and explanatory content, promoting an intuitive experience

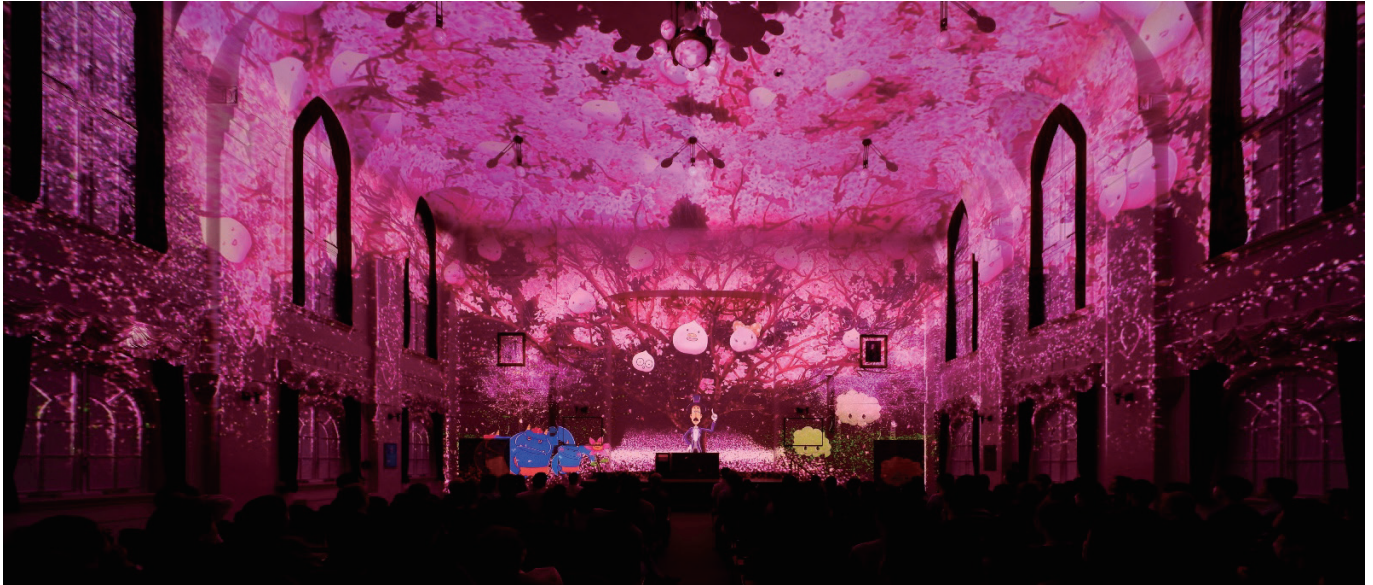
Journey of Water in Oku-Nikko

Water gushing from Senjogahara Plateau transforms into the Yugawa River, traversing mountain streams and cascading over waterfalls before reaching Lake Chuzenji, down to the Kegon Falls. This immersive content offers a floating sensation while surrounding visitors with live-action projections of the Oku-Nikko water's journey.

Life in the Wetlands

On an 8K-resolution-wide screen, embark on a journey through the seasonal rhythms of life in the Oku-Nikko wetlands. Witness the activities of rare plants and elusive birds that are rarely observed with the naked eye.

A Musical Projection Mapping that Shares the Founder's Vision, Re-Screened After a Decade

The projection mapping performance HARUJI-SENSEI'S CLASSROOM OF DREAMS is an original story that brings Haruji Nakamura, the founder of Seikei Gakuen, back to life to teach us the things that truly matter. This new story, complemented by songs, transforms Nakamura's teachings into a captivating musical and visual experience. It was staged in the iconic main auditorium of Seikei Gakuen, a building with a proud, 100-year history.

First produced and screened in 2015, the show returned in 2024 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Nakamura's passing. Enhanced with five 4K projectors, the re-screening delivered an immersive storytelling experience that embodies universal qualities and remains as impactful as it was nearly a decade ago.
